



Northwest Parkway Marshall Fire Toll Rebate Program

The Northwest Parkway (NWP) wishes to support those in our community who had their homes destroyed by the Marshall fire. This program is meant to help families that had their lives turned upside down by the fire, by offering reimbursement for their tolls on the Northwest Parkway. The program will offer up to **\$100,000** in toll relief to those families.

Program Details:

The following describes the process for seeking toll credit to affected families, NWP reserves the right to revise or change the process and requirements at any time.

1. Applications must be submitted to NWPmarshallfire@nwpsy.com . The application form is below or can be found online at: <http://www.nwpsy.com/mediadraft.html#MarshallFire>
2. Applicants must present proof that their home was destroyed by the Marshall fire - A copy of the driver's license, or insurance claim, or other proof of residence (utility bill within 2 months of the fire).
3. Applicants must not have any outstanding balance due with the Northwest Parkway.
4. Applicants must have a valid ExpressToll account in **good standing** now and for the duration of the program. If applicant does not have an ExpressToll account, you can open one here: www.expresstoll.com/Login. Select "Create Account" and follow the instructions. You may also contact the ExpressToll Customer Service: www.expresstoll.com/ContactUs to help you open an account.
5. Maximum of 2 vehicles (2-axles) registered per household. Both approved vehicles must be added in the ExpressToll account, have a properly mounted ExpressToll transponder, and not have any outstanding balance.
6. This Program is valid for **tolls on the Northwest Parkway only, occurred between: February 1 - December 31, 2022.**
7. The Northwest Parkway has established a fund of up to a total of \$100,000 to refund valid paid tolls to qualified applicants. **The funds will be applied on a first-served basis, until the \$100,000 has been disbursed or until the program's expiration date - midnight of 12/31/2022**, whichever occurs first.
8. Participants will be notified via email once the program terminates, either due to the fund being fully expended or the program's expiration. Participants shall be responsible for all other tolls incurred not covered.
9. Approved applicants will receive a monthly toll credit posted in their ExpressToll account for the qualified tolls paid on the previous month.
